# Contact

The EPP is available to children and young adults aged 25 and under from families obtaining the following benefits and who do not receive any apprenticeship pay:

- Unemployment benefits (Arbeitslosengeld II) or social benefits (Sozialgeld) (Vol II of the German Social Code (SGB II))
- Social welfare benefits (Sozialhilfe) or basic social security provisions (Grundsicherung)
- Èligible benefit recipients under AsylbLG (German Asylum Seekers Benefits Act)
- Child allowance (German Child Allowance Act, BKGG)
- Housing allowance (BKGG)

The EPP supports and promotes children and young people from low-income families. Families often find it financially impossible for their children to join sports clubs or take part in after-school activitites. Families often can't afford to pay for lunches at school, kindergarten or day-care or to send their children on school trips and excursions.
